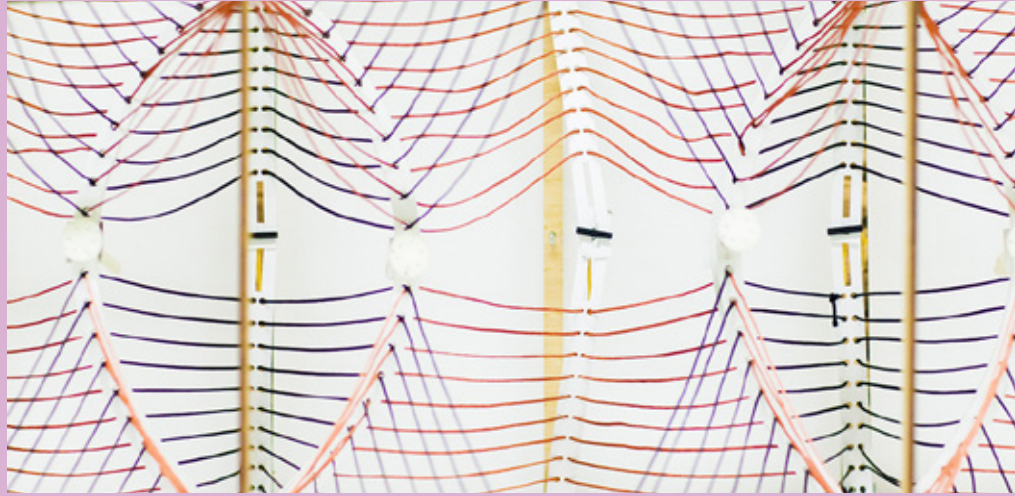

This course has been designed by the Design, Strategy and Management team at ELISAVA and is being executed in collaboration with Rotterdam Business School.
